 - Biblical peace is about more than a feeling. It is wholeness and human flourishing.
 - When the worshipper finds acceptance by God through <u>atonement</u>, he is now in a position to <u>celebrate</u> being at peace with God.
 - Three forms of the peace offering (Lev. 7:15-16)
 - 1) <u>Thank</u> offering public declaration of God's blessing or deliverance (Ps. 107:22)
 - 2) <u>Votive</u> offering payment of a vow (1 Sam. 1)
 - 3) <u>Free-Will</u> offering –general gratitude to God
 - The detailed regulations of Lev. 3 and Lev. 7 imply that peace with God can only be achieved on His <u>terms</u> and not our <u>own</u>.
