- 1. <u>Ritual</u> Atonement for the <u>Presence</u> of God (vv. 1-19)
  - a. The "mercy seat" was the place where God <u>met</u> with and <u>cleansed</u> His people.
  - b. The blood sacrifice is a <u>demonstration</u> of Israel's <u>defilement</u> and establishes the <u>urgency</u> of annual <u>atonement</u>.
  - c. The blood of Jesus is the <u>ultimate</u> atonement.
  - d. In Christ, we have more than <u>annual</u> atonement, we have <u>eternal</u> redemption. (Heb. 7-9)
  - e. The Day of Atonement <u>purified</u>, but never made <u>perfect</u>. (Heb. 10:1)
  - f. The OT priests served in the Tabernacle <u>continually</u>, but Jesus sits at the right hand of God <u>eternally</u>. (Heb. 10:11-12)
  - g. In Christ, our conscience is <u>clear</u> and our guilt is <u>gone</u>! (Heb. 10:22)
