- 1 Instructions on <u>Provision</u> for the Holy <u>Place</u> of God (1-9)
 - d. God's people are called to serve Him continually. (1-4)
 - i. God's people were responsible for supplying the sanctuary.
 - ii. God's priests were responsible for serving in the sanctuary.
 - iii. Light represents God's holiness and God's truth.
 - e. God's people fellowship with Him confidently. (5-9)
 - i. Loafs were a symbol of fellowship with and <u>acceptance</u> by God.
 - ii. Loafs were used to act out Israel's covenant relationship with God. (v. 9)
