## The Community of the Cross – Part VII Eph. 4:17-24

- <u>Doctrinal</u> Basis for Christian <u>Purity</u> (17-24)
  - o Paul is calling us to appropriate kingdom culture.
  - o Paul contrasts the life of pagan <u>futility</u> with the new life of Christian <u>purity</u>.
  - A desensitized <u>heart</u> leads to a darkening of the <u>intellect</u>.
  - o Pagan futility not only <u>rationalizes</u> its behavior, but then seeks to <u>normalize</u> it.
  - So the progression goes from rationalization, to normalization, and finally to marginalization of those who do not conform.
  - Those who profess Christian faith but don't practice Christian faith are <u>professors</u> but not possessors.
  - We must take <u>off</u> the comfortable clothes of the old life and put on the <u>new</u> clothes of the new life.
- <u>Practical</u> Guidance for Renewed <u>Community</u> (25-32)
  - o Paul focuses on <u>relationships</u> within the church.
  - o 4 Examples:
    - 1) Fellowship can never be built on falsehood.
    - 2) Control our anger.
      - Don't let it lead us to sin.
      - Don't let it linger.
      - Don't give the devil an opportunity.
    - 3) Don't illegally re-<u>distribute</u> other people's property, but personally <u>contribute</u> with your own honest labor.
    - 4) Don't make a <u>septic</u> tank out of your <u>speech</u>.
  - o Summary:
    - Verse 31: Diligently to put away sinful vice.
    - Verse 32: <u>Deliberately</u> pursue kingdom <u>virtue</u>.
