- The Prelude to Paul's Prayer (vv. 14-15)
 - Paul's prayer motivated by and begins with adoration to God for all that He has done.
 - There is no limit to God's resources and riches.
- The Progression of Paul's Prayer (vv. 16-19)
 - The first petition is a request for power.
 - Paul prays that the churches will be strengthened by the Spirit.
 - The strengthening of the Spirit and the indwelling of Christ are two sides of the same coin.
 - But Jesus doesn't come to take part, He comes to take over.
 - Christian faith isn't primarily about you having Jesus, it's about Jesus having you.
 - All of this results in our being deeply grounded in love.
 - Love is the native soil for the Christian life to grow and flourish.
 - Love is the foundation on which the Christian life is built.
 - The second petition is for knowledge.
 - Paul wants us to know the unknowable love of Christ.
 - Knowing Christ's love is accomplished "with all the saints" in the church!
 - If you do not experience the love of Christ reigning through you, you can't comprehend Christ's love for you.
 - This is a prayer for Christian maturity.
- The Purpose of Paul's Prayer (vv. 20-21)
 - To God be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus, to all generations forever and ever. Amen.
