- 1. Escalation of God's Demands on His People (vv. 17-20)
 - a. Jesus confirmed the <u>authority</u> of the Old Testament.
 - b. Jesus fulfilled the prophecies of the Old Testament.
 - i. Jesus didn't just keep the Law, Jesus completed the Law. (v. 18; Rom. 10:4)
 - c. Jesus taught His followers to <u>obey</u> the Old Testament.
 - i. We are empowered for greater <u>righteousness</u> by the Spirit of Christ.
 - ii. We obey in light of the <u>accomplishment</u> of Christ.
- 2. <u>Illustrations</u> of God's <u>Designs</u> for His People (vv. 21-48)
 - a. The examples of "greater righteousness" are suggestive, not exhaustive.
 - b. We control anger <u>urgently</u>. (5:21-26)
