2. The Peril of False Prophets (vv. 15-20)

    - v. God's people must exercise discernment.
  - b. Assumption: Good trees produce good fruit.
    - i. Don't look at the clothes the teacher wears but the fruit the teacher bears.
    - ii. The good shepherd protects the flock from predators.
    - iii. The good shepherd does not flee from danger.
    - iv. The good shepherd feeds and doesn't fleece the sheep.
    - v. The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
3. The Pleas of False Converts (vv. 21-23)
