- 1. The <u>Path</u> to <u>Fulfilled</u> Life (vv. 13-14)
  - a. Two Roads: <u>Broad</u> Way and <u>Rough</u> Road
  - b. Two Gates: Wide Gate and Straight Gate
  - c. Two Destinations: Ultimate Destruction and Eternal Life
- 2. The <u>Peril</u> of <u>False</u> Prophets (vv. 15-20)
  - a. Assumption: Bad trees produce <u>bad</u> fruit.
    - i. False teachers are <u>dangerous</u>.
    - ii. False teachers are deceptive.
    - iii. False teachers <u>damage</u> the flock.
    - iv. False teachers <u>devour</u> the flock.
    - v. God's people must exercise discernment.
  - b. Assumption: Good trees produce good fruit.
    - i. Don't look at the clothes the teacher <u>wears</u> but the fruit the teacher <u>bears</u>.
