1. Authority over Disease (8:1-4; 14-17)

  - a. Like Namaan, the outsider becomes the insider. (Ps. 107:3)
3. Authority over Discipleship (I) (8:18-22)
  - a. Discipleship demands sustained sacrifice (vv. 19-20) and supreme allegiance. (vv. 21-22)
4. Authority over Disaster (8:23-27)
  - a. God was sovereign over the waters in the beginning (Gen. 1:1-7), separated the sea at the Exodus (Ex. 14:21-22), and stilled the storm in Jonah (Jonah 1:4-16).
5. Authority over Demons (8:28-34)
  - a. The disciples' question: "What kind of man is this?" (v. 27)
  - b. The demon's confession: "Son of God." (v. 29)
6. Authority over Self-Destruction (9:1-8)
  - a. Only God has authority to forgive sins. (Is. 43:25)
7. Authority over Dishonor (9:9-13)
  - a. Jesus came to restore those who are in exile.
8. Authority over Discipleship (II) (9:14-17)
  - a. The gospel involves celebration and self-denial.
9. Authority over Defilement (9:18-26)
  - a. Uncleaness is a lack of human wholeness.
10. Authority over Death (9:25)
  - a. Death is the ultimate result of defilement. (Lev. 15:31)
12. Authority over Darkness (9:27-31)
  - a. In the messianic age, the blind will see. (Is. 35:5)
13. Authority over Dumbness (9:32-33; Is. 35:6)
  - a. In the messianic age, the dumb will sing. (Is. 35:6)
14. Jesus has ALL authority! (Mt. 28:18-20)
