- We can even boast in the midst of <u>tribulations</u> because of the unshakeable hope we have in Christ.

The <u>Certainty</u> of Christian Hope (vv. 5-11)

- Paul gives us two <u>reasons</u> to trust in the hope that peace with God brings.
- The first reason is the <u>subjective</u> experience of God's Spirit pouring out His love in our hearts.
- There is one God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit is present in the life of every believer.
- But this isn't just about feeling, it's also about <u>fruit</u>. (Gal. 5:22)
- Verses 6-8 give us the <u>objective</u> ground for the certainty of Christian hope.
- While we were yet <u>sinners</u>, Christ <u>died</u> for us!
