The Significance of Christian Hope (vv. 1-5)

- Because we are justified by faith in Christ, we now have peace with God.
- In the biblical world, peace (shalom) referred to wholeness or completeness. Things were as God meant them to be.
- This peace is not a subjective emotion, but an objective, accomplished fact.
- Paul is emphatic that peace with God comes through Christ alone.
- And we exult or boast in the hope of God's glory.
- We can even boast in the midst of tribulations because of the unshakeable hope we have in Christ.

The Certainty of Christian Hope (vv. 5-11)

- Paul gives us two reasons to trust in the hope that peace with God brings.
- The first reason is the subjective experience of God's Spirit pouring out His love in our hearts.
- There is one God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit is present in the life of every believer.
- But this isn't just about feeling, it's also about fruit. (Gal. 5:22)
- Verses 6-8 give us the objective ground for the certainty of Christian hope.
- While we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!
