  - Our baptism depicts our death with Christ—it is the <u>funeral</u> of our old life.
  - The obvious point is that it is impossible for us to truly <u>profess</u> Christ and yet continue to <u>pursue</u> sin.
  - If we are united with Christ in His death, we are also united with Christ in His resurrection.
  - This is not resuscitation to the old life but going <u>through</u> death and into God's new life.
- The Urgency of Our <u>Imitation</u> of Christ
  - Paul takes it as foundational that when God redeems, He also <u>renews</u>.
  - The <u>unchanged</u> life is an <u>unconverted</u> life.
  - In verse 11, Paul wants us to <u>apply</u> to our lives what Christ has already <u>achieved</u>.
  - To imitate Christ we have to <u>continually</u> remind ourselves of who we are in Christ.
  - Verse 12 is the practical <u>conclusion</u> of our union with Christ.
  - Do not let sin <u>reign</u> in your mortal body.
