  - Baptism is a symbol of our union with Christ or participation in Christ's death and resurrection.
  - Our old self under Adam was crucified with Christ so that we may be liberated from the tyranny of sin.
  - Our baptism depicts our death with Christ—it is the funeral of our old life.
  - The obvious point is that it is impossible for us to truly profess Christ and yet continue to pursue sin.
  - If we are united with Christ in His death, we are also united with Christ in His resurrection.
  - This is not resuscitation to the old life but going through death and into God's new life.
- The Urgency of Our Imitation of Christ
  - Paul takes it as foundational that when God redeems, He also renews.
  - The unchanged life is an unconverted life.
  - In verse 11, Paul wants us to apply to our lives what Christ has already achieved.
  - To imitate Christ we have to continually remind ourselves of who we are in Christ.
  - Verse 12 is the practical conclusion of our union with Christ.
  - Do not let sin reign in your mortal body.
